As Returning Officer for the Scottish Borders my team and I are committed to ensuring that elections are accessible, inclusive, and welcoming for everyone. We recognise that people with disabilities — including those experiencing sight loss, deafness, mobility challenges, and other access needs — may face barriers when exercising their right to vote. It is our responsibility to listen, learn, and act to remove those barriers wherever possible.

We are beginning a programme of engagement to better understand your experiences and to work together on improvements. To do this effectively, we want to hear directly from you and your organisations about:

- **How you would like to engage with us** — whether through in-person sessions, digital meetings, or visits to your groups so we can hear about your experiences directly.
- **What changes or support would make voting easier and more accessible for you** — from the physical environment of polling stations, to information formats, communication support, and any other aspects of the voting process.
- **Your ideas for ongoing collaboration** — so that accessibility remains at the heart of how elections are delivered in the Scottish Borders.

Your voices are essential in shaping a voting experience that works for everyone. We want to build a partnership where accessibility is not an afterthought, but a central part of our planning and delivery.
